Robbie Harte is an award-winning international country music recording artist based in New York. Originally from Montreal, Canada, Robbie is known for her honest and motivating songwriting, her warm, rich vocals, and her heartfelt delivery. She captivates audiences with songs that inspire resilience and hope.

Robbie's journey towards music was shaped by her own adversity. After a life-changing injury left her with chronic pain and temporarily silenced her voice, she discovered that music was the key to her healing. Determined to show her young daughter that disabilities should never limit ambition, Robbie embraced her passion and launched her career.


In 2017, Robbie began writing and developing her own personal sound and style, paving the way for her breakout single 17 in 2020, which topped the charts multiple times. Since then, her music has received consistent airplay in the US and abroad, frequently reaching the #1 spot and solidifying her presence in the indie country music scene. Her latest hit, My Mama's Daughter, achieved international success, reaching the number one spot on the Canadian and US charts and secured a place in the top ten in the UK, France, and Germany. Additionally, it ranked #4 on Yangaroo's Top CanCon Downloads and #5 on Yangaroo's Most Active Indies.

Her success has earned her numerous awards and accolades, allowing her soulful songs and stories to connect with fans worldwide.

In 2022, Robbie won the ISSA 'Songwriter of the Year' award and 'Single of the Year' award for her single "Outside My Window." In 2023, she received nominations for the Josie Music Awards and the Who's Who Country Music Awards. Most recently, in 2024, she was honored with multiple nominations, including "Rising Star - Country," and won the Josie Music Award for "Music Video of the Year - Performance Focused" for her video Sticks and Stones, presented at the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville. In 2025, Robbie's heartfelt Duet 'Love Like That' with Lynne Swaney won Best Country Ballad at the Fairplay Country Music Awards in the Netherlands.

Robbie has performed at renowned venues such as The Horizon Stage at Bethel Woods Center for the Arts, The Long Island Music Hall of Fame, The Bitter End in New York, and stages in Nashville, Atlanta, London (UK), Toronto, and her hometown of Montreal.

Beyond her music, Robbie is a voiceover artist and was the former host of Country Crops. A proud member of CMA and CCMA, she is also a Breedlove Artist and a passionate advocate for disability awareness and acceptance.

DISCOGRAPHY

Robbie released her debut EP, "I of the Storm," in late 2020. This collection of empowering songs gained international airplay and inspired listeners worldwide. The title track, "I of the Storm," is an anthem about being fragile yet unbreakable, often underestimated and misjudged. It has become Robbie's theme song.

"Out of the Blue" is an upbeat song that radiates summer vibes, telling the story of how trading Paris for Paradise and taking a chance led to finding love unexpectedly.

"You Don't Belong Here" is her most vulnerable and powerful song to date, showcasing Robbie confronting the demons of her past and declaring they no longer have a place in her life. This song was featured in the ChildHelp Monthly Newsletter.

"Home Is Wherever You Are" is a beautifully heartfelt ballad that addresses the challenges people face during these precarious and unprecedented times, particularly the difficulty of spending time with family and friends and creating new memories—especially during the holidays.

"17" is a nostalgic love song that reflects on the journey of love throughout the years. This was Robbie's breakout song that established her on the Country Music scene in 2020.

In September 2021, Robbie released her single "Outside My Window," inspired by the tragic loss of a young life in her community. This song was launched ahead of World Suicide Awareness and Prevention Day and went on to win Bronze Single of the Year at the 2022 ISSA Awards. Robbie's electrified rendition of "Jingle Bell Rock" was released in December 2021, followed by her feel-good single "Handle With Care" (a Traveling Wilburys cover) in January 2022.

Her summer single "Too Pretty to Be Home" was released in May 2022, receiving multiple international chart placements. Both the song and its music video received award nominations, with one reviewer stating: "One of the highlights of 2022 on Banks Radio Australia and Valley FM 89.5, this track provides a sublime wall of sound, amazing vocals, and a sensational track." - Isaac Banks Jr, Banks Radio Australia / Valley FM 89.5.

"Reason to Rise," released in September 2022, delivers a much-needed message of hope that continues to resonate globally. This inspiring anthem earned multiple award nominations and won Social Stars' "Best Song of the Year."

On September 2024, Robbie released "Sawdust on the Floor," which quickly broke into the Top 10 charts in the US, UK, Australia, and Canada. In Canada, it made the Billboard Top 25 Anglo Country chart and was among the top-downloaded country songs on Yangaroo. The track was also highlighted as one of Billboard Canada's "Most Active Indies."

In November 2024, Robbie released a deeply heartfelt rendition of Leonard Cohen's timeless classic, "Hallelujah," offering a moving tribute that resonated with longtime fans and new audiences alike.

Robbie's pop-country anthem "The In Between" dropped in April 2025 and made waves internationally. The song received broad airplay and charted in Canada, the UK, the US, and Australia. It also ranked among the Top Country Downloads on Yangaroo on both April 26 and 28. "The In Between" was nominated for Country Pop Song of the Year at the 2025 Josie Music Awards.


